The Public Hearing was called to order by Mrs. Vilardi at 7:00 P.M.

No public comment on the proposed Local Law #2 of 2018 regarding overriding the tax levy limit. Motion made by Mrs. Foster, seconded by Mr. Schlicht, to close the Public Hearing at 7:01 PM. Another Motion made by Mrs. Foster, seconded by Mr. Schlicht, to adopt Local Law #2 of 2018 regarding overriding the tax levy limit. Both motions PASSED – Ayes –5, Nays – 0. Voting aye – Vilardi, Conway, Schlicht, Foster, Brown.

FINANCIAL REPORT: Mr. Chartrand has received the employee benefits money. The General Fund is at 66% of budget and Highway is at 43% of budget. The Public Hearing for the budget adoption is scheduled for Wednesday, November 7th at 5:00 PM. Motion by Mr. Schlicht, seconded by Mrs. Foster, to hold a Public Hearing on November 7, 2018 and to have Mrs. Riker advertise the Public Hearing. Motion PASSED – Ayes – 5, Nays – 0. Voting aye – Vilardi, Conway, Schlicht, Foster, Brown.

ZONING REPORT: Mr. Decker said there's been more construction than he's seen in 10 years.

HIGHWAY REPORT: The plows are on the trucks and summer projects are complete. Annual safety training is due for the Town officials, at the same cost as last year. Mr. Virgil will set up a time.

HISTORIAN: No report.

HISTORICAL SOCIETY: Ms. Beglinger opened the museum in September for 26 people, 19 of which were children, bringing the total for the year to 468.

NEW BUSINESS:

Fire District: Mr. Tom Herlihy reported the insurance company would charge \$177/person for cancer coverage. He will have to revise their preliminary budget. The 10-year lease is up with the Town. Mr.

Herlihy will work with Mr. DeMore to renew the lease. The new lighted sign is working well. Mr. Herlihy and Mr. Mike Rankin will be the contact people for the sign.

OLD BUSINESS:

S.O.T.S.: Dependable Disposal is ahead of schedule delivering the new totes. The new pickup schedule will begin November 5th, but a flier is expected to be mailed explaining the recyclable schedule.
